In 2014, West Suburban Humane Society celebrated 42 years of helping animals in need. It's been an incredible 42 years, and I've been humbled and proud to have spent the last 15 years leading this fine organization.

During that time, I've seen our adoptions grow stronger and stronger. Last year we placed over 670 animals in permanent, loving new homes. All of these animals were spayed/neutered and microchipped before leaving the shelter. This is a big step toward our goal of preventing pet overpopulation and reuniting lost pets with their owners.

We were also fortunate to receive several significant bequests. This money will be used to ensure the continued quality care of the homeless animals at the shelter and to help us strive toward the goal of building a new facility.

I'd like to offer a heartfelt thank you to all of our wonderful supporters who so generously contributed to our work in 2014. Every dollar is important and enables us to further our mission of helping the sick, injured, abused and homeless animals that make their way to the shelter each year. We couldn't do it without your help and generosity.

## Letter from West Suburban Humane Society's Board President

### With Thanks to Our Family of Supporters

I am very proud to introduce this 2014 Annual Report from the West Suburban Humane Society. We had a wonderful year; our largest annual fundraiser, BarkaPALooza, raised more money for the animals than ever before and 670 dogs and cats found new, loving homes. West Suburban Humane Society is fortunate to have enough support from our donors and local community that we were able to assist not only local homeless animals but also accept animals from Oklahoma and Tennessee where there is a critical shortage of loving homes for dogs and cats. I've been on the Board of Directors since 2008 and I believe West Suburban Humane Society sets itself apart from other shelters by the lengths we are willing to go for our animals. Not only do we go above and beyond with medical care to ensure the long term comfort and health of our animals, we also house most of our cats in an open floor plan "cattery" to promote their natural behaviors and reduce stress. We provide behavioral training for dogs who need some help fitting into suburban family life and we hire runners to exercise our high energy dogs which really helps with their stress level so they can find a new home that much faster.



One of our program highlights in 2014 was creation of a Legacy Society to promote commitment to West Suburban Humane Society by leaving a legacy of financial support through a bequest (or other planned gift arrangement) to the shelter. We received notable bequests this year that have been invaluable in planning for the continued success of the West Suburban Humane Society. Our goal with this program is to ensure that everyone knows that there are many ways a donor can help local homeless cats and dogs.

Another almost year-long effort, led by the Board and West Suburban Humane Society staff, was creation of an Awareness Perception Survey sent to all of our volunteers, foster parents, donors, adopters and community leaders. We received almost 1,000 responses full of valuable information which will guide our interactions with all of our supporters and members of our community.

Of course, West Suburban Humane Society could not function without its volunteers. In 2014, almost 600 volunteers spent over 3,000 hours a month caring for our dogs and cats, promoting the shelter at community events, planning and implementing our fundraisers, and the many other jobs that keep our facility operational. We are so grateful for the time and energy you each spend to help those who cannot help themselves. We are also grateful for our business partners listed on page 7 that perform veterinary and other services at a discount which allows us to further fulfill our mission.

On behalf of the West Suburban Humane Society Board of Directors, I want to thank everyone reading this 2014 Annual Report. Most of you are already giving your time and money to our animals we are honored that you chose to support the West Suburban Humane Society. To those of you reading this report and hearing about the West Suburban Humane Society for the first time, thanks to you as well. All of our Board members, staff and volunteers are passionate about caring and finding homes for homeless dogs and cats. We believe there is nothing more rewarding than to care for, provide companionship and work to find a new loving family for a scared, rejected animal. That you are reading this report means that you too care about these animals and that makes you one of us. Part of the West Suburban Humane Society family. And we thank you.

# About WSHS

West Suburban Humane Society (WSHS) is a volunteer-based, animal welfare organization that was founded in 1972 as a lost and found referral service. We provide housing for up to 25 dogs and 60 cats at a time. We operate at full capacity at all times with animal care and adoptions being provided by four full-time and seven part-time employees and more than 650 volunteers. Our facility is open to the public six days a week. We continue to reunite lost animals and their owners by maintaining a database with information on more than 33,000 pets and their owners, and by providing free pet identification tags to all pet owners.

## Mission

WSHS is dedicated to operating a premier animal shelter for the purpose of finding safe, permanent and compatible homes to adopt domestic dogs and cats. We are committed to educating and encouraging the public to humanely care for dogs and cats.

## Vision

WSHS will achieve and sustain its reputation for being the premier humane organization in Illinois. To achieve such recognition, WSHS will focus on the following critical components:

*Advocacy:* WSHS will promote the humane care of dogs and cats by working with government agencies and other agencies to promote the humane care of animals.

*Care:* WSHS will be the preeminent provider of animal care, working with high quality veterinarians to provide the most appropriate medical treatment for non-terminal conditions of cats and dogs in our care. Further, WSHS will develop innovative practices, such as working with reputable trainers in the area to ensure that every animal in our care receives the best total care before being adopted by the most compatible owner.

*Education:* WSHS will educate our staff, volunteers and members of the community on proper pet health care and safety. We will provide ample information and constant support to our adoptive families and act as an invaluable resource for educating the public at large.

*Fundraising:* WSHS will remain financially solvent and transparent so that we can continue to focus on finding new sources of revenue and maintaining our relationship with those who have provided financial contributions.

*Values:* We believe in the following core values:

- Serving as a resource to educate the community and animal owners about responsible dog and cat care.
- Providing high quality medical treatment for animals in our care.
- Controlling the pet population through spay and neuter
- To always act ethically and in the best interests of both animals and potential adopters.
- Appreciating our dedicated volunteers and staff
- Working as a team to develop creative solutions for potential adopters and achieve the best results
- Having fun and enjoying our work

## WSHS Success Stories

### Baby Grey – A Second Chance

Baby Grey's owner had a dying wish: That the West Suburban Humane Society would take his cat in and find that cat a forever home. Of course we said yes, but Baby Grey took his owner's death hard, and had difficulty adjusting to life in a shelter cage. He was depressed, wouldn't eat, and he lost weight and began going in and out of his litter box over and over again.

We took him to the vet, who diagnosed Baby Grey with bladder stones. Medication and a special diet didn't work, and one of the stones was so large it was blocking his urethra, almost killing him. He needed surgery, and WSHS provided the funds for it.

After a long recovery in a volunteer's home, Baby Grey is feeling like his old self. He is happy, healthy and playing like a kitten! Lucky for Baby Grey, his foster family fell in love with him and decided to make him a permanent member of their family.

West Suburban Humane Society depends on everyone who supports our mission. If it weren't for that support, Baby Grey would not be with us today. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts!



### Margarita – Against All Odds

On a cold day in early March, the transport from Montgomery County Animal Control pulled into the shelter. As humane society staff unloaded dogs from their crates, we noticed one huddled in the back, shaking, not making eye contact with anyone. We thought after a few days in the kennel, poor Margarita would come around and her fear would go away. She was so shut down, we decided to send her to a foster home for socialization.

Once in a home instead of the kennel, Margarita made fast progress. She became a normal dog: playful, friendly and loyal. When she was ready to find a forever home, we sent her to the vet to be spayed. While she was there, the vet found a heart murmur and recommended an echocardiogram. The results of the echocardiogram revealed that Margarita had pulmonic stenosis and ventricular hypertrophy. Unfortunately, Margarita needed heart surgery. So off to U of I she went for a balloon valvuloplasty.

Margarita recovered well and her foster home decided to adopt her. She is happy, healthy and enjoying life in her forever home, and the cost of her surgery is a small price to pay for the joy she brings to everyone around her.

Margarita would never have had this opportunity without the backing of the WSHS supporters. Your donations ensure that the homeless animals at WSHS get the same medical care to which your own dogs and cats have access.

At the West Suburban Humane Society, we never turn our backs on an animal in need.

Since our founding in 1972, the shelter has relied completely on the generosity of its donors to provide animal care and shelter for thousands of cats and dogs. Veterinary care costs our shelter more than \$100,000 each year, and that's with the generous discounts our partner vets are able to provide. Pet food and animal care, all add up to more than \$200,000 annually.

Our building is old and was not designed as a shelter, and though we do the best we can with what we have, our mission is to operate a premier animal shelter, giving our animals, volunteers and adopters the best experience we can. While we operate on a very tight budget, several generous gifts have provided seed money to begin exploring shelter plans and construction designs.

Before we can commit to such a large project, however, we need to ensure all our current needs can be met. Our first responsibility is to our animals, and as we look to the future we must maintain the present. ## What Makes WSHS Special

In 2011, WSHS was able to recognize one of our biggest dreams. We remodeled our cattery and went from cats living in cages to cats enjoying a spacious, open cattery. Since opening the cattery, our cat adoptions have increased by 5%. Outbreaks of upper respiratory and other feline illnesses have decreased by almost 50%. The cats are happier, healthier and more adoptable! 341 cats were adopted in 2014.

In 2007, WSHS founded one of our most important programs, the STAR (Special Training and Reinforcement) program. The STAR program sends dogs with behavioral problems to camp. The problems can range from difficult-to-handle or aggression to shyness and overall confidence building. Many animals have been neglected and abused and have developed negative behaviors to help them cope. The program allows dogs a smoother transition to successful adoption placement. In addition, the quick transition helps to free up available space for other animals needing to be placed up for adoption. Seventeen STAR dogs were adopted in 2014.

In 2012, WSHS held its first Junior Volunteer Summer Camp. The one week camp for kids' ages 9 to 12 years was a huge success. The objective our summer camp was to provide accurate information so kids understand the consequences of their decisions as pet owners; instill reverence, respect and responsibility so kids will act with kindness; and offer positive choices that benefit both people and animals so kids feel empowered to help create a more humane world. In 2014 we held 2 weeks of summer camp with a total of 19 kids in attendance.

At WSHS, a dedicated staff, volunteer base and the retained service of several veterinarians has allowed us to save the lives of and place over 600 homeless animals each year into new homes. Every animal that is brought to our shelter receives whatever type of veterinary care that is needed, including surgery and hospitalization for trauma cases, long-term care and medication for viral and bacterial infections, and treatment of parasite infestations such as heartworm. Orphaned kittens and puppies as well as the infirm receive loving care in our Temporary Care Homes until they are ready for adoption.
