



- Water, snacks, first aid, and dog curbing materials will be provided along the route for you and your leashed canine companion. Please scoop up after your pet.
- All participating dogs should be current on vaccinations and wearing an I.D. tag.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. No retractable leashes, please.
- In order to be eligible for prizes, all pledges are due on or before event date.
