## Group Tours

The West Suburban Humane Society offers tours of the shelter for scouts and other groups. The tour includes an opportunity to learn about what we do and our guiding philosophy. A portion of the tour is dedicated to socializing with some of our animals.

### Schedule

Tours are by appointment only and are a maximum of one-hour in length. Preferred time slots include:

Tuesdays – 3:30 or 4:30 p.m.

Wednesdays – 4:30 p.m.

Thursdays - 3:30 or 4:30 p.m.

### Maximums

Groups are limited to a maximum of 12 individuals (including any adults who accompany the group). Groups of eight or more will be split into two groups and rotate through the center. In some cases, it may be necessary to schedule larger groups on two separate dates.

To avoid overcrowding in the shelter, parents who drop-off children are generally not able to participate in the tour and should either wait in their vehicle or return at the designated time to pick-up their child.

### Donations

For each tour, we ask for a \$3 donation per participant. This should be collected by the group leader(s) in advance. We can accept cash or check (payable to WSHS). After the tour, fun scout patches can be purchased for an additional \$2.00 each.
